Using Stacked Templates to Build Books

Introduction

In ProSelect, stacked templates allow you to efficiently build books using pre-designed layouts and customizable options. This guide will walk you through selecting a book design, choosing appropriate stacked templates, and using them to create and edit pages within your project.

Understanding Book Designs

Before creating a book, you need to select a **Book Design**.

- The selected Book Design appears on the top bar in thumbnail view.
- These designs are based on lab specifications, and ProSelect comes preloaded with several default designs.
- For this example, we'll use the 10x10 default Book Design.

Selecting and Using Stacked Templates

- 1. Locate Book Page Templates
 - Find book page templates in the Resource area below the main workspace.
 - Since we're using a square book design, use **square templates**.
- 2. Choose the Template Category
 - Click the drop-down arrow next to Categories.
 - Select Stacked Album/Book Pages.

- 3. Select a Folder
 - In the folder section, choose Square Stacked Pages.
 - You'll see four square templates. Each has a stack icon in the bottom corner, meaning multiple templates are grouped together in one stack.

Creating the First Book Page

- 4. Add a Template to the Working Area
 - Select the 1 Opening page template and drag it into the working area.
- 5. Add an Image
 - From the image list, **drag and drop** an image into the page template.
- 6. Enter Show Pages View
 - Double-click the page to enter Show Pages View.
- 7. Navigate Template Options
 - Select the book page.
 - The bottom-right corner of the info bar shows how many options exist within the stack.
 - Right-click on the Next or Previous Stack tool to see all available options.
 - Use the **up and down arrow keys** to move through different designs in the stack.
 - You can also use the Next/Previous Stack tools directly to browse.
- 8. Crop and Adjust
 - Once you've chosen your preferred layout, press the C key to open Cropping
 View.
 - Adjust your image using the cropping tools.
 - Press the T key to return to Thumbnail View.

Creating a Page Spread

- 9. Select the Spread Folder
 - Choose the Square Stacked Spreads folder.
 - Select the 4 Opening spread template.

10. Add Multiple Images

- In the image list, hold **Shift** to select multiple images (e.g., four).
- **Drag and drop** the selected images into the 4 Opening stacked page template.

11. View and Adjust the Spread

- The spread appears in your working area with images populated.
- **Double-click** the page to enter Show Pages View.
- Use the **up and down arrow keys** to navigate through stacked layout options.

12. Swap and Crop Images

- To swap images, drag one image onto another—the change updates across all stacked templates.
- Press C to enter cropping view and refine image placement.
- Adjust crops using the toolbar tools or arrow keys.
